A flier was passed for Hangyourpride.com that has a product similar to Fathead. It is a fundraiser for the club in that \$10 of each order comes back to the TDC. Your own picture can be used (4 md or 720 dpi minimum) or you can purchase the Scioto football helmet.. The owner is an alum of DCS system.

A grill has been purchased and the decision has been made to purchase 2 EZ up type tents (10x10) which are much more portable than the larger 20x20 semi-perm type.

Hoggy's will be participating in a "Hog of the Week" program recognizing an OL or DL for their outstanding play. Also perhaps with a ticket stub incentive of some sort.

The "Irish 12th Man Club" will happen. Paypal will be the vender and Keith W. will work on the design and implementation.

We will be participating in a fundraiser with AT&T. They will be set up inside the fence on Friday night.. Some dates to remember. May 19th parent meeting, summer camp 7/14 - 7/19, family cookout/meet the coach 8/7, Irish After Five 8/16.

Also discussed was the various venders and ideas for Clothwear .
